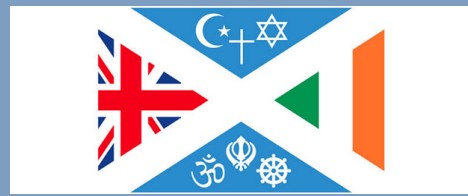
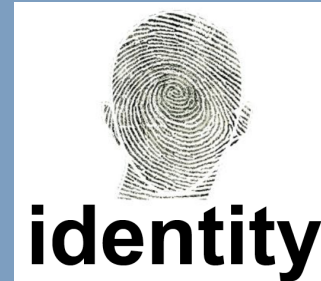


## My family history: a project



### The aims:

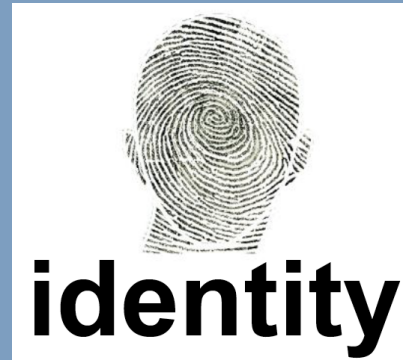
- To understand more about your own identity

**1. Describe your own identity.**

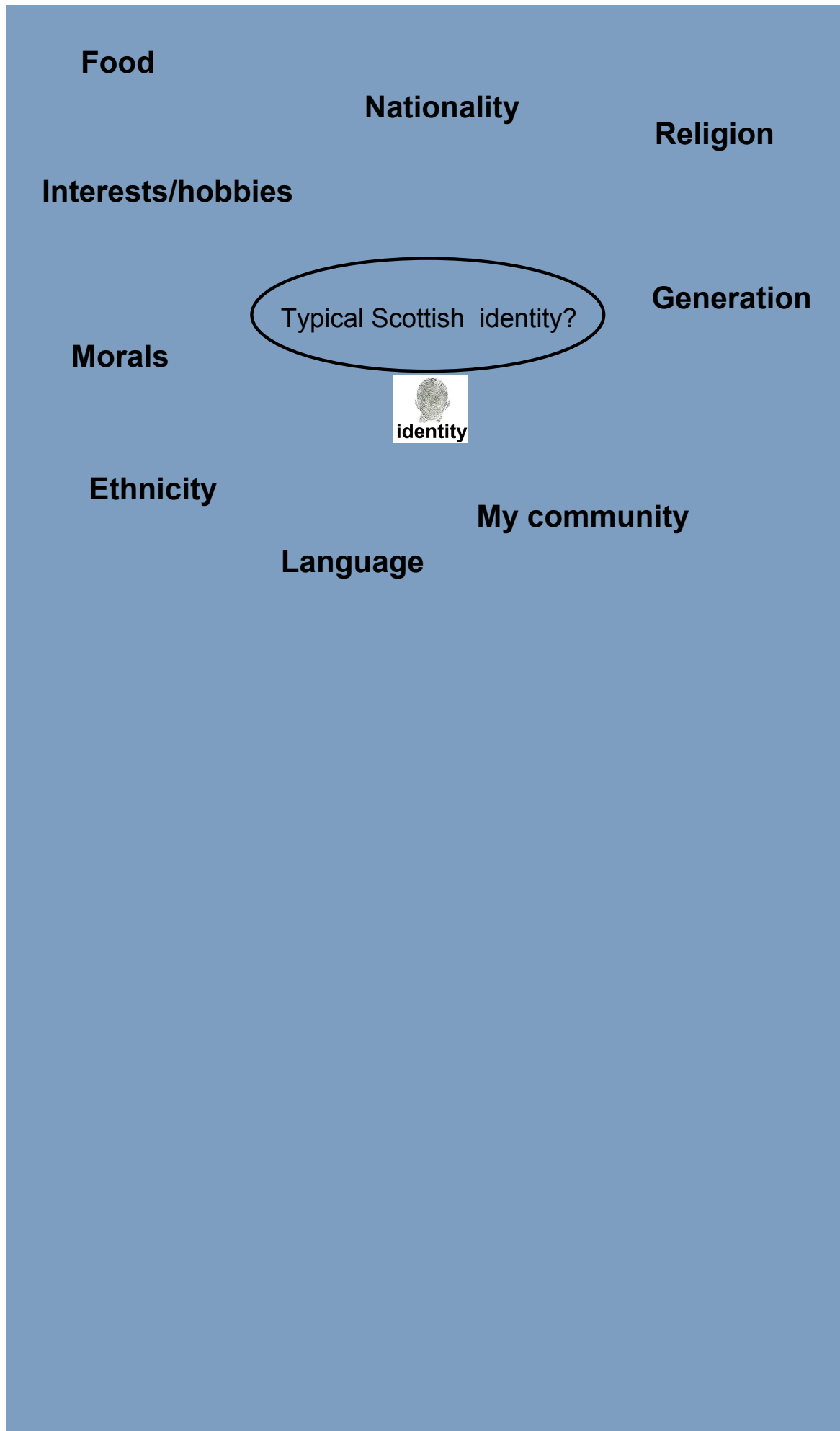


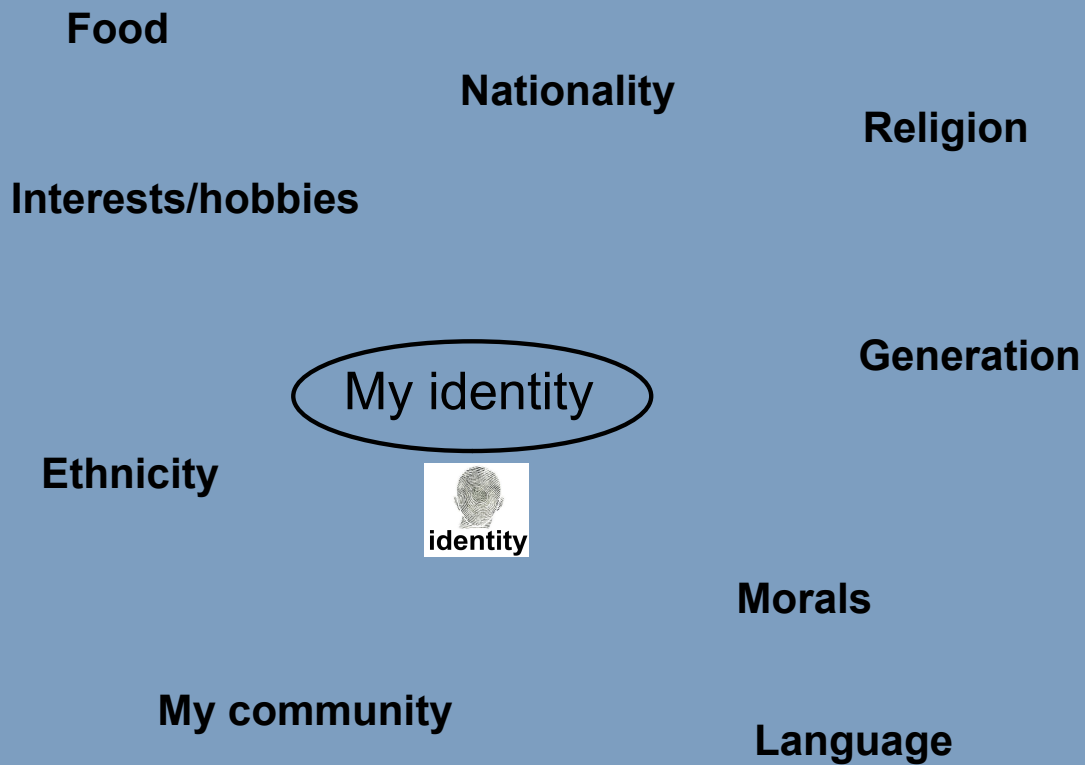
When you identify with something, someone or somewhere it helps form your **identity**.
