## Scotland's People: immigration

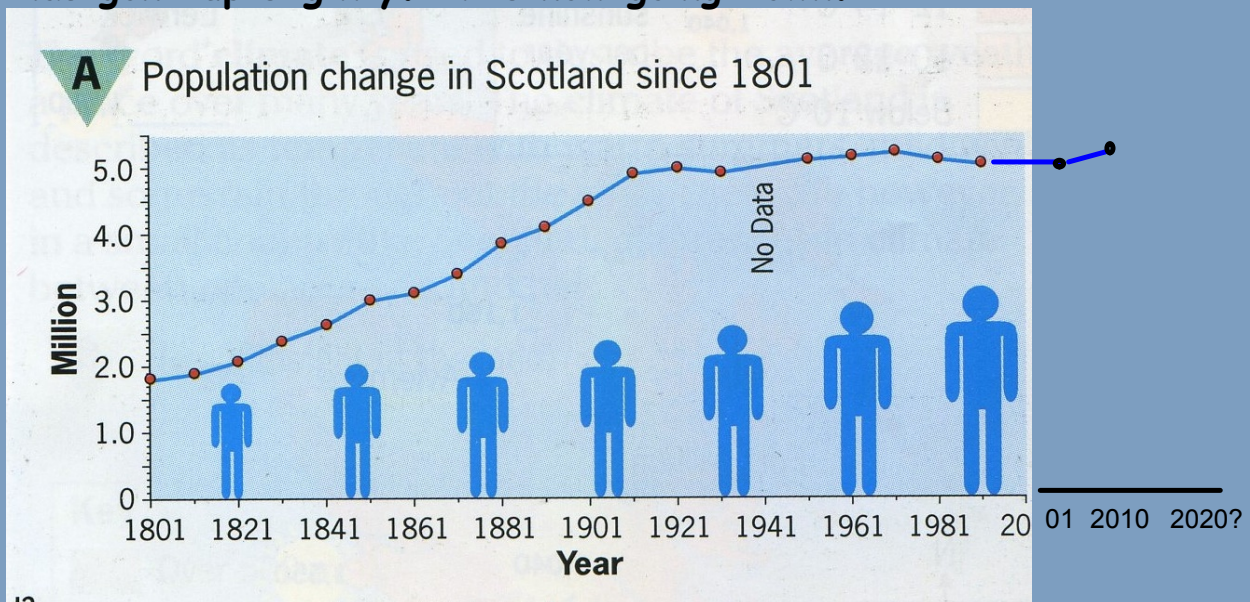

There are 5,194,000 people living in Scotland, that's less than 10% of the total population of the UK. The number of people living in Scotland had been going down since 1971, but recently has gone up slightly. It is now going down.



**In 2010 Scotland's population was estimated to be at 5,194,000**

People have been moving in and out of Scotland for thousands of years. The movement of people from one place to another is called **MIGRATION**. People moving into the country is called **immigration**.

People who migrate into a country are called **immigrants** and those who migrate out are called **emigrants**. Migrations in the past have left their mark on place names, religions, language and buildings.
