

There are 5,194,000 people living in Scotland, that's less than 10% of the total population of the UK. The number of people living in Scotland had been going down since 1971, but recently has gone up slightly. It is now going down.

People who migrate into a country are called immigrants and those who migrate out are called emigrants Migrations in the past have left their mark on place names, religions, language and buildings.






